

MAINE JUNIOR II CHAMPIONSHIPS

Congratulations on your selection to the Maine Junior II ski team. We have an exciting three days of racing ahead of us. **The total cost for the trip will be \$255.00**; Checks are to be made out to **“Maine Nordic Team”**. *The Dates for the races are March 7th-9th In Jackson, NH*. NENSA membership is required for all skiers to participate. This membership is not included in your fee for the trip. If you are not a member of NENSA, please go to the NENSA website for application information, fill out the application and send it in with your membership fee. Maine Nordic Team warm-up Jackets are available to order. They are made by VOMax and are navy blue and gold. The cost for the jackets will be an additional \$100.00 that is not included in the trip costs. If you would like a jacket please include the extra payment with the trip costs and we will order you one. There is a minimum of 12 jackets per order. If that minimum is not reached your money will be refunded.

The team will be staying at the Eagle Mountain Lodge in Jackson, NH. All meals will be provided for the team. Breakfast will be provided at the lodge and will consist of oatmeal, cereal, and bagels. Lunches will be done at the Lodge on Saturday and Sunday and will consist of sandwiches and other luncheon foods. We will have a team dinner at the Lodge on Friday night and a banquet with awards on Saturday night. If there are specific foods that you would like please bring them with you. Snacks are a great thing for the nights as well. We want you all to race as fast as you can and being well fed is important. Please also bring your own water bottle and belt for when you are skiing.

There will be no transportation to the event provided. You are required to be at the Eagle mountain lodge in Jackson, NH by noon on Friday the 7th for a team meeting. At this meeting you will meet your coaches for the weekend and pick up your bibs.

Both pairs of skis should be race waxed prior to arrival to the race on Friday. We will wax your skis on Saturday and Sunday for the remaining races. I will send out an email Thursday morning with waxing recommendations for Fridays and Saturdays race. *All skis should be well marked with your full name and classic ski kick zones should be cleaned before arrival.*
