Entries: Coaches must use the spreadsheet on the website. Entries must be entered in the spreadsheet and emailed by **5:00pm Wednesday, January 12th**. Email the spreadsheet to reaster@mac.com. Schools who send entries after Wednesday will be charged \$50.00 and their skiers may be at the end of the start list. The registration list will be posted on the MHSS website on Thursday, January 13th for verification.

Spreadsheet: You need to edit it, add athletes for your current team, then indicate a seed position starting at 1 for first out for Girls and Boys, then 2, 3, 4 and so on. In the gender column, put either M or F. You can add as many rows as needed.

Parking Info: Buses should park just beyond the new ski lodge. Spectators will need to park prior to the lodge. Parking attendants will direct vehicles and busses.

Electricity: There will be no electrical outlets available.

Registration Info: Registration will be from 7:30-9:30am. It will be located inside the new lodge.

Restrooms: There will be porta-potties.

Awards: The awards presentation will be in the stadium after results have been tabulated (approx. 3:00pm). Roy Varney Hornet Classic water bottles will be given to the top 5 males and top 5 females. Ribbons will be given to individual finishers 6th-10th. Top 10 finishers will also receive a great prize from LL Bean such as a fleece, socks, US Ski Team hats. The top two male and female teams will each receive a plaque.



Concessions: There will be a concession stand selling hot/cold drinks, snacks, hot foods (i.e. chili, meatballs, hotdogs). It will be located in the new lodge.
