We are looking forward to your participation in the KVAC Nordic Championship Events on March 3 and March 10, 2021. Our volunteers and staff have put together a safe and gratifying racing venue at Titcomb Mountain and wanted to update you on a few items.

First, we recognize the challenges you all have faced this season. We have put together details that we would ask you to convey to your athletes and families.

A. We will set two areas at Titcomb for this event, a Race area (includes the stadium and trails leading from the stadium to racecourse) for the athletes competing at 1 pm; Staging area for the group waiting to race at 3:00 pm (this includes the airport which will be used for warmup) There will be signage.

B. We ask the girls to use their buses while they wait to race. The Titcomb dome tent is to be used by the boys for storing their gear and warm up.

C. There are NO SPECTATORS allowed. Please convey this to families. The boys will race first, and girls will not be allowed on course to spectate. Boys will not be allowed on course while girls compete. Coaches and Course monitors will be allowed on course during competition.

D. Masks required on the Titcomb Mountain grounds and athletes will wear masks while racing.

E. Coaches, in compliance with Covid-19 guidelines, please make sure you screen all athletes and they are healthy to race on race day.

F. Registration – Open at 11 am - Bibs may be picked up for registered athletes at Registration Headquarters. Following the event, please ask athletes to deposit bibs in the bucket at the finish corral.

G. The 5K high school course will be used; see map attached.

We have an electrical panel allowing for waxing. We ask coaches to socially distance while setting up wax tables and tents and please do not block the doors of the maintenance building. Also, you may want to bring a 50-100 ft electrical cord. Many of you bring your own generators and you should still plan to do this, as our wax service will be available on a first come first serve basis.

Parking for buses will be assisted by our Titcomb staff.
